New Mexico hosts Los Alamos National Lab, Sandia Lab, the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant, and dozens of military-industrial corporations among other facilities of the national nuclear weapons complex. Current US military and nuclear weapons policy calls for a renewed expansion of the nuclear weapons complex, weapons research, and military spending.
